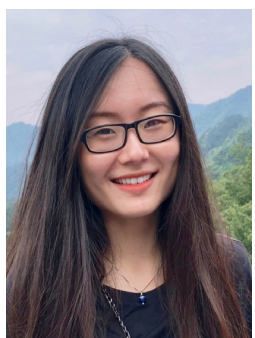
Mr Bryan Kit Yue Ng - Tang Oxford Award in Environmental Sciences

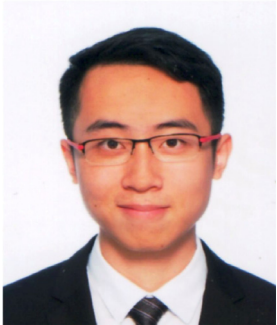
Mr Xiao Su - Wei Oxford Award
