The China Oxford Scholarship Fund is pleased to inform our friends and supporters that after challenges caused by the pandemic, some of our awards panels were able to conduct in-person interviews with shortlisted applicants this year. The Hong Kong Awards Panel and the Oxford Awards Panel were able to carry out mainly in-person interviews over the summer. The Oxford interviews took place at Hertford College where Oxford Panel Chairman, Prof. Michael Wooldridge, is a Senior Research Fellow. Working with Prof. Wooldridge were COSF UK Trustees Xiaodi Bell and Dyan Sterling. Our Beijing and Shanghai Panels continued to conduct video interviews for 2022 due to the on-going Covid safety measures in place in those locations.

We are grateful to Hong Kong Trustee Kenneth Fok for arranging office and administrative support for the Hong Kong interviews. Kenneth's team helped in organising video conferencing equipment for the remote video interviews especially for the Beijing and Shanghai Awards Panels. Big thanks also to Hertford College for enabling COSF to use its premises for the in-person interviews at Oxford .

Since COSF was established, it has disbursed 346 scholarships with a total value of £1.83 million. We congratulate the fourteen scholarship awardees for the 2022/2023 academic year and look forward to welcoming this new cohort of China Oxford Scholars into our network of scholar alumni, friends and supporters. Mr Yuzhou Zhou - Yan Oxford Award

Yuzhou is a first-year DPhil student in Computer Science and is attending Jesus College. He has been awarded a Clarendon Scholarship at Oxford University.
